The Building Project

The project is based on members’ priorities. Our next step will be a more detailed design phase with ongoing member input. While embracing the themes of renewal, accessibility, and enhancement, we will aim to make UU Marin more welcoming for current and future members and the larger community while increasing program potential.



- A redesigned flow from the parking lot through the entryway will lead to a beautiful, **widened hallway** inviting people into the courtyard.
- New **gender-neutral ADA restrooms** will be accessible from the hallway.
- Members as well as event guests will enjoy **smooth pavers**, native plants, and a **water feature** in the courtyard.
- On the lower level, a refurbished “**Joy and Justice Education and Daycare Center**” will be accessible by a regular-size **elevator**. New underground drainage and an updated sewer line will protect the building, and a repaired lower “sunset deck” will lead to a new children’s play area.

Other details including but not limited to new storage closets, solar, new sliding doors, a relocated shed and trash enclosure, and Fellowship Hall enhancements will add to both aesthetics and functionality.
